12:00 p.m. – Break for Lunch; can stay on-site or “picnic” at a local park, beach etc.


12:30 p.m. – Resume work

Retreat Experiences


Each night after dinner and free time, we have a group gathering with a theme and some type of group bonding activity with a spiritual component. We debrief from the day and share what each group did that day.

What to Bring:

- Pillow
- Sheets and a blanket or Sleeping bag

 - Work pants (shirts and pants are required for work sites: no tank tops or shorts are allowed on work sites)
**We will supply a T-shirt to be worn at the worksites*
- 2 casual outfit
- Bathing suit
- Work boots
- Hat (not a visor but a full hat, helpful if it covers the ears and shields the face)
- Leisure clothes (no revealing clothing; tight shirts or spaghetti strap tank tops)
- Leisure shoes (tennis shoes/sandals/ flip flops)
- Rain gear (a must!)
- Towel (2) & toiletries, flip flops for the shower
- Modest pajamas
- Sunscreen
- Hand sanitizer
- Bug repellent
- A big plastic bag for dirty laundry (it will smell!!)
- Water bottle (write your name on it!)
- Work gloves
- Sun glasses
- Allergy medication (if needed)
- Spending money (meals for travel days / souvenirs)
- Rosary Beads
- Bible and or Journal if you want it
- An open and positive attitude!

Paperwork & Deadlines:


Final Deadline to Register is March 1st.
